Articles - up to 5 pages, including figures and tables, font Times New Roman, size 12, single spacing, paragraph - 1.25 cm, sheet orientation - portrait, margins 2.0 cm on all sides. Figures will be reproduced in black and white, therefore, if they are included in the text in color, their understanding should be checked when black-white printing. The languages of the article and abstract are not limited. Article file name: Ivanov.doc.

The cited literature is given at the end of the article in the order of citation and is formatted in accordance with the requirements of GOST 7.0.5.-2008, and when referring to the text, the serial number of the source and, if necessary, the page (for example, when citing) are

indicated in square brackets.

The collection is assigned ISBN, library codes (UDC, BBK). The authors of published materials are responsible for the content of the materials. The originality of the text must be at least 65%. The texts of the articles are published in the author's version, so they must be carefully prepared.
